

**Expression of Interest  
Team PEI History Book Project**

The 2027 Canada Games will mark 60 years of the Games and Prince Edward Island's Provincial Canada Games Committee (PCGC) is working on a project to commemorate PEI's participation in them. Since 1967 Island athletes, coaches, officials and mission staff have been representing PEI at the Games and there have been many incredible stories on the field of play and around the Games.

The PCGC is looking to create a list of writers and/or researchers who may be interested in working on this project. The idea is to build a collection of stories over the past sixty years and format it into a book and host it on a website.

Any person interested in the project must meet the following criteria:

- Born during or prior to 1971
- Have some history or knowledge of writing or researching in sporting environments
- Be knowledgeable of the Canada Games
- Currently residing in PEI

The initial call is to create a list of writers and researchers who may be interested in this project. The project may involve one writer and/or researcher or multiple writers and researchers working collaboratively to complete this project by February 2027. After the list is generated, the PCGC will follow up with a call for proposals and will include more details on the outputs, timeline and the remuneration for the work.
